AGRICULTURE *and its impacts.*

This year, our agricultural support programs in Les Cayes saw remarkable success, with local farmers harvesting a total of 17,425 kg of produce. This achievement not only supports local families but also significantly contributes to the economic stability of the community.



Impact Highlights:

- **Economic Contribution:** The harvested produce has played a critical role in rejuvenating the local economy, providing both sustenance and a source of income for the community.

- **Access to Healthcare:** The mobile clinics facilitated crucial health check-ups, treatments, and preventive care, reaching a significant number of individuals in remote areas.
- **Focus on Women and Children:** Special attention was given to maternal and child health, ensuring that vulnerable groups received the care needed to promote healthy development.
